Our Cause

The breast cancer mortality rate in the Mahoning Valley is among the highest in the nation. This has been due to lack of education, awareness and access to early detection and diagnostic services. The goal of Panerathon is to change that. 100% of your sponsorship dollars go directly to the Mercy Health Foundation Mahoning Valley to support the Joanie Abdu Comprehensive Breast Care Center (JACBCC) at St. Elizabeth Hospital, and 100% stays here in the Mahoning Valley.

Since the JACBCC opened in November 2011

- Over 42,000 exams have been performed at the center.
- In 2015, the highest percentage of breast cancers were diagnosed in Stage I. In previous years this had been Stage II.
- Nearly 1,000 diagnostics were provided to women through Joanie's Promise. These include screening and diagnostic mammograms, ultrasounds and biopsies.
- The Center has received National Accreditation within its first year of operation, has won many accolades including the Press Ganey Guardian of Excellence which is based on our 99% patient satisfaction as well as the Women's Choice Award; the ONLY Breast Center in the Nation to receive the designation.
- The Center has reached thousands of people in the Valley through outreach efforts which include educating women on proper breast care techniques.
- This convenient and state of the art facility would not be available without the support and generosity of the Panerathon sponsors, participants and the community.

About the Joanie Abdu Comprehensive Breast Care Center

Joanie Abdu served as a nurse at St. Elizabeth for more than 20 years. She was a role model for other nurses and was highly respected by physicians, staff, patients and families. After she married Dr. Rashid Abdu, she volunteered for many projects and fundraising activities at St. Elizabeth. In 1993, Joanie was diagnosed with an aggressive form of breast cancer. She lost her battle and died June 2, 1994, 15 months to the day she was diagnosed. After Joanie's death, Dr Abdu became committed to researching, planning and creating a comprehensive breast care center at St. Elizabeth. Diagnosis time is shortened to eliminate the agonizing wait for patients and family members, where physicians treating each patient confer on the best treatment options for each individual patient.

Joanie's Promise Fund is just that; a promise that ALL women regardless of their ability to pay, will have access to world class breast care right here in our Valley!

"Through my ears, Joanie hears the voices of grateful women for the care they will receive in this magnificent facility. Through my eyes, she sees the reality of what once was only a dream. Through our souls, we both see the beauty, the love, the compassion and the generosity of a caring community that has made that dream come true.
